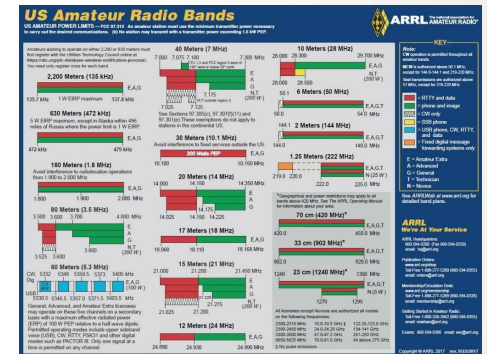

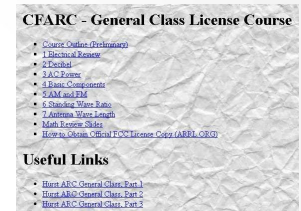

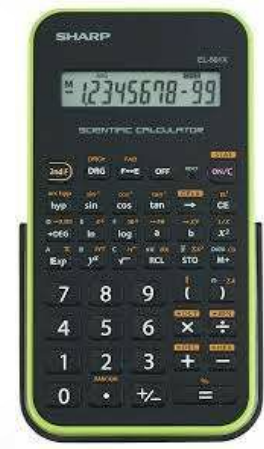
Calculator

- Sharp EL-501X Scientific Calculator provided during course and exam



Sharp EL-501X

- Algebraic format
- Four functions +, -, *, and / plus +/-
- = to evaluate
- log for decibels
- 2nd F 10^x for anti-log
- Square root for RMS
