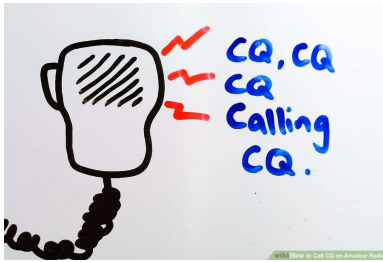







General Class License Course



The Cuyahoga Falls Amateur Radio Club (cfarc.org) is offering a six session (3 ½ hours per session) GENERAL CLASS license course at the Akron-Summit County Public Library – Main Branch¹ from 1:15 PM to 4:45 PM starting 17 February 2019. There is free parking in the deck next to the library with ADA access for all via a ramp and elevators.







-  Do you have a technician class license?
-  Do you want to move into HF and talk around the world?
-  Do you want to learn more about components and circuits, radio signals and equipment, digital modes, antennas and propagation?
-  Do you want to help in emergencies outside your immediate area?
-  Would you like to become a Volunteer Examiner?

If you have a technician class license and any or all of these amateur radio adventures excite you, you should earn your general class license. The course will meet on six consecutive Sundays starting 17 February 2019. The lecture will be the first five Sundays and will cover background material and the entire element 3, 462-question pool. On 24 March 2019, the following Sunday, a Laurel VEC sanctioned open test session will be administered. If you are successful in answering 26 or more of the 35 questions on the Element 3 examination you are granted privileges immediately.



The cost of the course is \$35 which includes the W5YI General Class License Manual by Gordon West, and refreshments. Any and all of the course fee may be waived for financial reasons.
