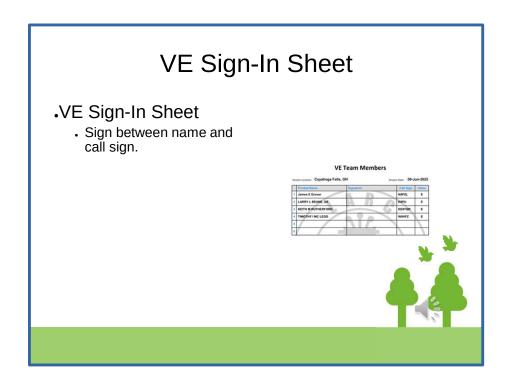


This set of slides is training for CFARC VEs for a given session.

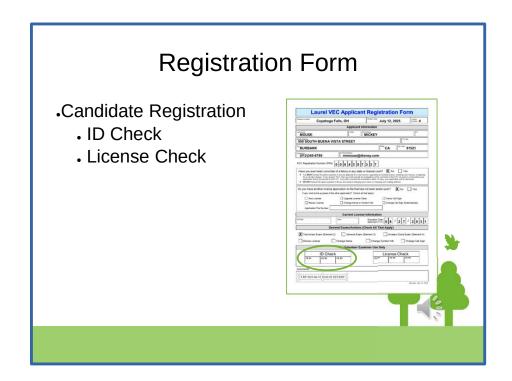
Only the first two phases are covered:

- 1. Pre Session
- 2. During Session

The third phase, Post Session, is only performed by the Team Leader in charge of session.



The first thing you should do on arrival is to fill-in the VE sign-in sheet. Sign opposite your name. If you are not on the list, then add your name as it appears on your license, your call sign, and your class. G for General and E for Amateur Extra.

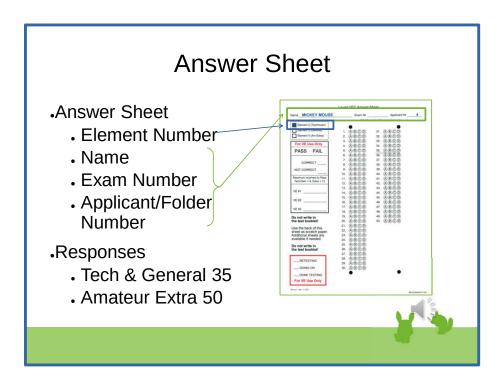


Next each candidate is call to the front of the room to check the candidate's identity with a photo ID. The name must match by first name and last name. So must the photo. The address does not need to match.

Then initial in the ID Check box if you are one of the first three VEs.

If a license check is required, then review the license and initial under License Check. Normal upgrades do not require a license to be presented, because Session Manager has already located the license in the FCC database.

An example where a license must be presented is to prove that the candidate had Technician privilege prior to 21 March 1987. Prior to that date, Technicians took the General license exam but only required 5 wpm code. This called an automatic upgrade.



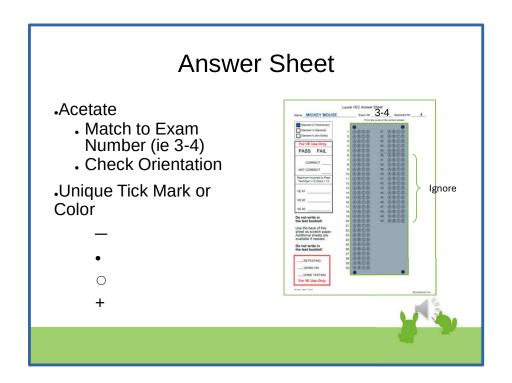
VEs will distribute an exam booklet and answer sheet to each candidate.

Match the placard number to the candidate's folder.

VEs will pass out the exam booklet for the current exam and the appropriate answer sheet.

Match the element number to the exam booklet.

Also check that the correct exam number is recorded at the top of the answer sheet.

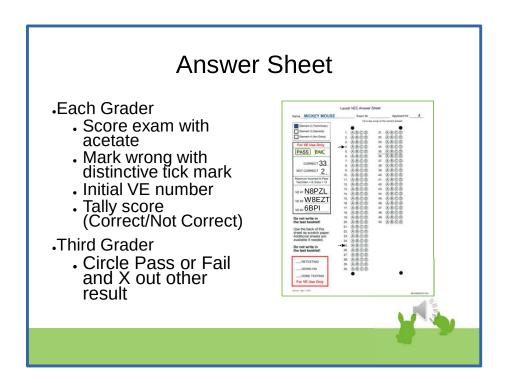


The runner should retrieve the exam booklet and answer sheet from the candidate when they indicate they are done.

The graders/certifiers should locate the appropriate acetate that matches the exam number on the answer sheet. Check the orientation and alignment marks in all four corners.

For Technician (element 2) and General (element 3) grade the first 35 responses. For Amateur Extra (element 4) grade all 50 responses.

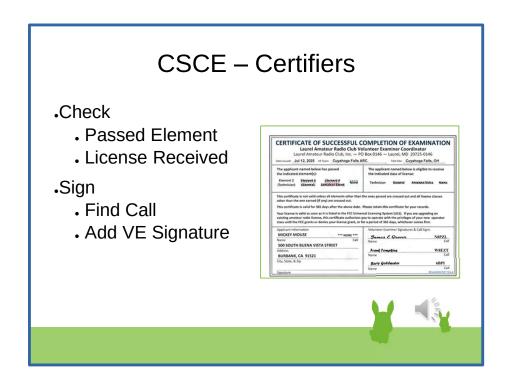
Either use a unique tick mark or a unique pen color to mark incorrect responses.



The first VE should tally the number of tick marks and place this number next to the not correct line. The second and third VE should check that this number is correct. Then write your call sign on the appropriate VE number line.

In addition, the third VE (VE #3) should figure and mark the correct number on the correct line. Circle PASS or FAIL depending on not correct answers. Cross out the other result. Return answer sheet and folder to Team Leader.

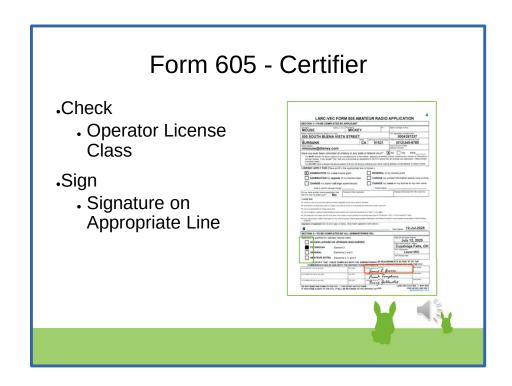
The Team Leader will mark RETESTING, GOING ON, or DONE TEST depending on candidate's status.



The Team Leader has checked and marked the answer sheets. If done testing, the CSCE and Form 605 will be sent to the Certifying VEs.

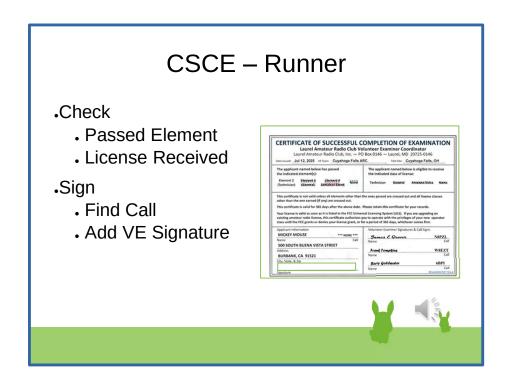
On the CSCE check that the Passed Element and the License Received lines are marked appropriately.

Sign next to your call sign signifying the Passed Element and the License Received lines are correct.



In addition, the Certifying VEs will complete the Form 605. On the Form 605, check that the qualified for operator license class is marked correctly.

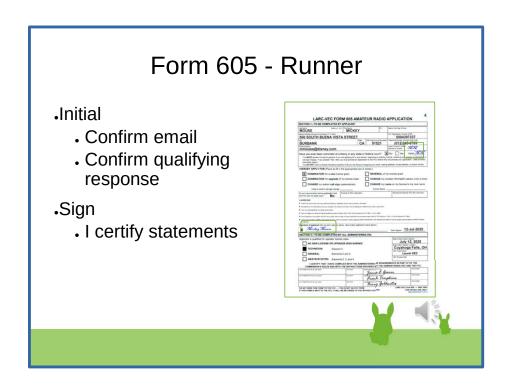
Sign the appropriate line certifying that the appropriate licenses has been earned.



The runner will obtain signatures and initials.

The runner may show answer sheets to candidate but retain them in the runner's possession and return to the candidate's folder.

Have the candidate sign the CSCE form and give the form to the candidate for their records.



The runner should ask the candidate to check the correctness and correct any errors in their email address. Then have them initial the appropriate box.

The runner should have the candidate confirm that they have answered the qualifying question correctly. Then have them initial the appropriate box.

Finally, the runner should have the candidate sign the Form 605 by the bold X. Retain the Form 605 for the session record in the candidate's folder.

Once all signatures and initials are obtained, excuse the candidate from the session. Retain the candidate number placard, Rule of the Session, and the Form 605 in the candidate's folder. Also retain any calculators, pens and pencils if they were provided.
